

The George Nikolopoulos Endowment Fund

The George Nikolopoulos Endowment Fund was established to promote, encourage, induce and advance Greek education. The main objectives of the fund are as follows:

- ◆ To provide scholarships for Universities to students who attended the Holy Trinity Greek School (HTGS) for at least six (6) years and graduated from it or have an interest in starting and/or continuing Hellenic Studies
- ◆ To provide funds for transportation expenses to the HTGS students who participate in exchange programs with sister schools in Greece.
- ◆ To provide funds for partial coverage of the expenses of the Greek school students who have been selected for programs of continuing education in Greece.
- ◆ To provide funds to cover the tuition fees of the Greek school for needy children.
- ◆ To provide funds to purchase (a) educational equipment for the Greek School and (b) Greek National costumes (Evzone-Amalia) to be kept at the Greek School and to be borrowed by the students for the Greek School programs (ex. 25th of March, 28th of October celebrations, etc.)

Application deadline for 2017 scholarships is May 31, 2017.
